MEETING FORMAT - 1. In accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, any response to a public comment on an item not listed on the published final agenda will be limited to a statement of factual information or an existing policy provided in response to the comment. Members of the public may speak for up to four minutes each on issues not included on the published final agenda, with a total of thirty minutes allowed. Any deliberation or decision by the Board must be limited to a proposal to add the subject to a future agenda.
2. Public Comment on Agenda Items: Members of the public may comment on any agenda item listed. They may speak for up to four minutes per agenda item they comment on, and for a total of up to thirty minutes per agenda item.

2. Budget and Tax Rate:
 1. Consider acting on the 2025-2026 budget. The budget must be adopted before the tax rate.

 - b. Take a record vote and schedule a public hearing
 - c. Authorize expense and publication of 'Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Increase' in the Hondo Anvil Herald, and
 - d. Acknowledge and approve the posting of 'Notice About 2025 Tax Rates' and 'Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Increase' to the home page of the MCESD6 website.
3. New Business – Introduction of Any New Business for Discussion and Appropriate Action:
 - A. September Tax Rate and Monthly Meeting and Public Hearing on Tax Increase – September 22, 2025; Adopt the budget, then the tax rate, and submit the tax rate to Medina County Tax Office, followed by the regular monthly meeting.
4. Adjourn:

The MCESD#6 Board of Commissioners reserves the right to adjourn into executive session at any time during this meeting to discuss any of the matters listed above, as authorized by the Texas Open Meetings Act, including but not limited to Texas Government Code §§ 551.071 (Consultation with Attorney; pending or contemplated litigation); 551.072 (Deliberation about Real Property); 551.073 (Deliberations about Gifts and Donations); 551.074 (Personnel Matters); 551.076 (Deliberation about Security Devices); and 551.087 (Economic Development); and any other provision under Texas law that permits a governmental body to discuss a matter in a closed executive session. Action, if any, will be taken in open sessions.
